This striking William IV mahogany leather upholstered reclining armchair has been upholstered in a beautiful deep buttoned black leather hide that is a great contrast with its good quality mahogany frame. The back of the antique armchair is of serpentine shape with a carved central relief and joins its base with metal hinges so to makes it able to recline. Both seat and backrest has been deep button upholstered in a black leather hide with black leather armrests and brass studwork to each side. The antique leather chair has two carved swan shaped arm supports and stands on two turned and reeded mahogany feet with carved patria's to the front and swept legs to the rear with brass castors. As this mahogany chair is a reclining chair it has a turned wooden button to the front left of the base of the arm which when pressed will release the mechanism that then enables the chair to recline to various positions whilst been supported by the central bar across the back. This Antique William IV reclining armchair is in very good condition with a great colour and is a fine example of its type which being able to recline has always been very sort after in the antiques market.
