A really striking and most unusual Jewellery or table box, French in origin dating to around 1860. The box has quality rounded edges but of course what makes this a rare example is the striking inlay creating a tartan or plaid-like look. The inlay is made from burl Holly bordered each side by Satinwood. The top is mounted with a gilded brass handle and the front is inlaid with a diamond shaped Mother of pearl escutcheon. There is a display key with tassle, but it is not functioning but creates a highly decorative finished look. The interior has been professionally re-lined in a linen textured hand-marbled paper creating a clean and fresh finish, ready for use.
