Definitely the most exquisite antique English hot water kettle I have had in a long, long time, dating to around 1890/1900, late Victorian in era. Made by the top-notch silversmith, Mappin & Webb of London & Sheffield, this is about as good as they get or as my silversmith said (when he professionally polished it for me), it's the bee's knees! The kettle is beautifully engraved with a variety of Ferns, so very English and so very Victorian; and sits of a stand supported by four most attractive legs with floral splayed feet. What makes this one so very special is the Ivory handle to the top carved with Ferns wrapping around it, quite exceptional. Again the quality is evident with the lid of the kettle having a top-notch flush hinge being topped by a welcoming Pineapple finial. It comes with provenance which I will include, a valuation from 1992 for the amount of £950.00 (approx. \$1520.00). Exceptional in every way and in superb condition.
