very handsome Victorian hipflask, made from a good gauge of sterling silver, the flask weighing 114.9 Grams or 3.69 Troy Ounces. It's a very usable size, not too large, not too small shaped with a concave back, created to fit perfectly into a pocket. The top has a hinged bayonet top requiring a twist and lift to open, the interior of the top retaining it's original cork filling to avoid evaporation of the precious contents. There are hallmarks to back, front and collar, the full mark is for the highly collectible Chester assay office and the year 1897, the makers mark is rubbed.
