This charming rug was made by the Salar khani Baluch tribe around 1880. The field design consists of two vertical rows of four and a bit 'gols' - tribal crests - similar to those of the Saryk Turkmen. Small highlights of silk can be found throughout the field and within the octagonal 'gols' as well as highlighting of yellow giving the rug a stunning appearance. A beautiful little rug. Size: 1.68m x 1.07m (5' 6" x 3' 6").
