The bodies are repoussé work and decorated with floral and foliate motifs. Each piece has gadrooned rims and feet. A stylish and practical set. Condition :- Very good with no splits or dents. The caster has a couple of minor blemishes around the centre, lost in the pattern and commensurate with age and use. The box has staining to the silk lining, but closes well.
