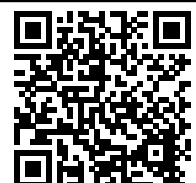

The silver surrounds a glass chamber with a star cut base, by looking at the underside of the inkwell, the construction becomes clear. The hinged lid opens to reveal a smaller removable ink chamber which makes it easy to refill with small amounts of ink and clean. Both base and lid are hallmarked with the makers initials J.G & S for the highly regarded silversmith, John Grinsell & Co.
