Oil on canvas in a 19th c. gilt frame. A good quality portrait of a gentleman of the George III period; he looks intently and seriously past the viewer. The portrait is of Lancelot Andrewes, a prosperous draper from Cheapside whose daughter Mary married in 1753 Edmund Keene. It has passed by descent through the Ruck-Keene family. The Rucks are descended from a family of German bankers who moved to England in the 1500s and settled in Suffolk. SIZE: 27 x 22.5 inches inc. frame. PROVENANCE: by descent.
