An Important Late Regency Mahogany Side Table, after a design by George Smith, the raised back board with a central panel with carved moulding and acanthus scrolled brackets, above the very well figured mahogany top of inverted breakfront form; incorporating three frieze drawers in well figured veneers and mahogany drawer linings, raised on monumental monopodia supports, each of tapered columnar form with lotus leaf carving, crowned by an acanthus carving and an ionic capital, the paw foot articulated with rounded knuckles and exposed claws, the twin paneled rear supports flanked by flat pilasters, on moulded plinths. The whole retaining a lovely colour and patina with exceptionally well figured veneers.
