The handles are pierced crowns, one dated 1837, the other 1897. It stands on a raised foot and is a rare and collectable item of Victorian silver. Condition :- Very good, with no dents or splits. It has one tiny blemish to the side, that can only be seen with persistence and is commensurate with age and use. Hallmarks :- Clear and readable. Maker :- George Maundsley Jackson. Diameter :- 8.5 cms. Width :- 13.25 cms. (to outside of handles).
