Description

A charming little Salt Bag, woven by Kurdish tribes of Quchan in north-east Persia around 1900-1920. Some 5,000 Kurdish families were moved from Kurdistan to Khorassan around 1500 in order to guard the area from incursions by Turkmen and Uzbeks. These Kurdish tribes were generally referred to as 'Kordi' in order to distinguish them from their original clans in Kurdistan. Size: 41cm x 27cm (16" x 11").
