The lid and front is beautifully cross-banded in Tulipwood and the front beautifully inlaid in a linear design creating a fluted pattern. The front has a little brass ring pull on a silver back plate to open the lid. The escutcheon is also silver mounted leading down to a silver mounted shield shaped mount. The box comes with a tasselled key. The interior is an absolute joy, retaining the complete fitted interior, and the interior of the lid beautifully inlaid.
