The hood with matching reeded columns and satinwood fretted decoration. The good 8 day movement with engraved silvered dial with second hand and date dials within. The movement has been fully serviced and is in perfect working order including the date. Comes with original brass bob pendulum and original cast weights. There is an old large retailer label pinned to the inner door with full provenience of the maker. The label from Archibald Stewart & Co. of Glasgow who were cabinetmakers, upholsterers and ship furnishers. The case is in very good original condition, there is a good old repair to the left corner of the dial which is hardly noticeable.
