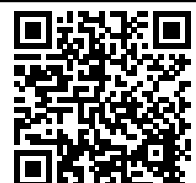

The lid opens to reveal an interior that has been re-lined creating a fresh and clean finish, perfect for many years of use. The brass pin which holds the bottom drawer in place, can be removed releasing the drawer to be opened.
