## Description

I have not been able to find out anything about this unusual Victorian game made from turned Walnut with polished brass fittings, dating to around 1890 I would imagine. The finial on the top is spun to turn the plate below the top plate and once stopped shows through the Dice results through three cut-out "windows" labelled 1, 2 and 3. Should the dice land in between values, the lever (floral looking lever) is used to shunt round the results to give a final value. The top brass plate is engraved "Lucky-go-round" / "New Game-at-Dice" / New Dice-Box By Royal Letters - Patent". A fabulous and really unusual piece of games history in excellent working condition. One of the turned feet on the underside has a slice out, but this doesn't detract in any way. 7" in diameter. Item ID: 34399 FREE Worldwide Registered Airmail Directly From London, England
