Description

A George III mahogany tilt-top round tea table with tripod legs and pad feet, having a turned central column support. This example although not the finest of examples, due to having had a very hard life, however still surviving with all the old repairs well hidden. The main circular top has naturally occurring shrinkage within the grain, causing the usual openings and splits, which have been filled probably back in Victorian times, and although the top has a lot of distress, the colour and heavily waxed finish provide a patina and charming character that more than makes up for things. Despite having had careful and solid repairs, my feeling and instinct was that this table was still a deserving piece to find space for within my old 17th century period home. * It must be noted that the flash photography rather gives the impression of a lighter colour of mahogany, when in fact it is a fair bit darker, still having a fabulous patina and depth of glaze hard to reproduce. That's why I had to buy it!!! There is a lovely large knot of wood towards the middle of the table top, which again looks wonderful re the texture and grain. Along side this runs a long vein of darker filled wood, w...
