Standing on well carved cabriole legs and joined by shaped and shell carved friezes with a serpentine and glass shaped front. The mahogany and plate glass fall lifts to allow access to an original velvet lined lockable interior (slightly worn). The upper stand cabinet with a single door and moulded corner detail with a finely carved cornice. The interior with 2 adjustable plate glass shelves. Not visible on photos- the very top is also plate glass. In good original condition with 1 or 2 bumps and bruises associated with age and use. Fully cleaned and waxed. With keys.
