This piece didn't start out like this, but has been reconstructed using old wood where possible from Victorian wardrobes, etc. It has all the features of the Victorian models, with the shark teeth supports for the adjustable shelves, carved corbels, a plinth base & a bold detachable cornice. It has all been French Polished & has lots of character. Width --- 34" (87cm) Depth of Cornice --- 13.5" (34) Depth of Sides --- 10.5" (27) Height --- 78" (199) Please note that this one was sold, but we do have these made to order regularly in any size & any wood according to individual requirements.
