A triple, chain-driven fusee bracket clock that strikes on 8 rods, playing the Westminster tune. The clock can be set, via a button on the face, to strike on either 4 or 8 rods. It strikes on the quarters. It strikes the hours on a separate coiled gong. The movement is made by one of the World's leading names in clockmaking, WINTERHALDER & HOFMEIER and is signed with their co. logo. The superb flame mahogany case is in excellent condition with box stringing to both the sides and front. It is beautifully french polished with a very clean, deep patina. It is fitted with gilded brass, lion head carrying handles to the sides. The clock stands on 4 adjustable brass bun feet. The 8" convex silvered dial is engraved with black Roman numerals and it has a heavy, cast brass bezel and convex glass. The beautifully crafted hands are original to the clock as are all other parts. It is very, VERY, rare to find a clock that is made to this standard of engineering.
