Description

A very nice example of these popular wallclocks. A rosewood case with excellent mother-of-pearl inlay. Unusually, this is complete in every respect and is a lovely complement to the beautifully polished case. The 12" dial has black Roman numerals and is signed M. PRESTON - LANCASTER. The 8 day, chain-driven fusee movement has just been fully serviced by our BHI registered staff. The brass pendulum can be seen swinging through a glass window to the lower half of the case when the clock is working. It has a heavy, cast brass bezel. There are inspection panels to both sides of the backbox and a hinged lower door to facilitate easy fitment of the pendulum.

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
