A splendid example of a rare Regency period wirework silver toastrack. This fine and rare piece dates from the early 19th Century and is of elegantly designed silver wirework. The four feet are cast and there is an oval handle. An elegant and practical example of George III silver tableware. Condition :- Veru good with no bereaks or dents. There are some signs that a couple of the supports have been resoldered to the base, which is very common with this type of Georgian wirework and commensurate with age and use. Hallmarks :- Clear and readable. Maker :- Edward Capper. Length :- 15 cms. Width :- 8 cms. Height :- 15 cms (highest point).
