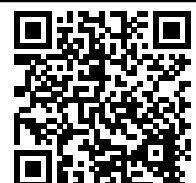
Description

An Antique Romanian Icon depicting St Constantine & St Helena, painted in oils on a pine panel with an ebonised integral frame. The reverse variously annotated with a list of hand written names and with reference to King Carol II of Romania. The panel is dated 1928 bottom right front, the reverse bears two dates one for 1930 and a restoration date for 1965 but the panel does look to be late 19th Century. 43cm x 29.5cm including frame Saint Helena also known as Saint Helen, Helena Augusta or Helena of Constantinople (ca. 246/50 – 18 August 330) was the consort of Emperor Constantius, and the mother of Emperor Constantine the Great. She is traditionally credited with finding the relics of the True Cross, with which she is invariably represented in Christian iconography. (ref. Wikipedia)
