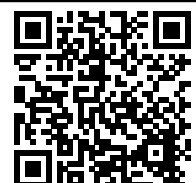

A beautifully modelled yellow, blue and orange coloured parrot, depicted perched on a three legged branch base stand in white, having gold hand painted decoration. ABOUT PARROTS. Parrots, also known as psittacines (pron.: /'s?t'sa?nz/), [2][3] are birds of the roughly 372 species in 86 genera that make up the order Psittaciformes, [4] found in most tropical and subtropical regions. The order is subdivided into three superfamilies: the Psittacoidea ('true' parrots), the Cacatuoidea (cockatoos) and the Strigopoidea (New Zealand parrots). [5] Parrots have a generally pantropical distribution with several species inhabiting temperate regions in the Southern Hemisphere as well. The greatest diversity of parrots is found in South America and Australasia. Characteristic features of parrots include a strong, curved bill, an upright stance, strong legs, and clawed zygodactyl feet. Many parrots are vividly coloured, and some are multi-coloured. The plumage of cockatoos ranges from mostly white to mostly black, with a mobile crest of feathers on the tops of their heads. Most parrots exhibit little...
