The jacket was high "Russian" collared, and was single breasted, with only 5 buttons. Shoulder boards were worn with this instead of cuff braid on the sleeves. No tie was worn with summer dress, and the only shirt would have been a sleeveless undershirt. Mess Dress: "Mess Dress", as it is called, was for formal occasions. Essentially the same uniform, it was white, and of much lighter fabric. FURTHER DETAILS TO FOLLOW ON THE POSSIBLE IDENTIFICATION OF THE SITTER AND HIS RANK.
