Description

C18th George III period mahogany long-case clock with signed movement by 'RICHARD MASON .St Albans'. Fitted with a classically-inspired design engraved silvered arch dial face with Roman numeral hour markings and Arabic minute and date markers. Fitted with blued steel hands, five-pillar, 8-day duration, hour-striking movement on bell together with brass date-hand. Intricate pierced fret-work sides to hood. Excellent quality grade of selected mahogany, having achieved a rich colour and patina. Fully-serviced movement, excellent time-keeping. High quality replacement brass finials standing on reeded blocks to top of hood. Prophetically inscribed to dial "THE MOMENT PAST LAYD MANY FAST". London-type top quality case with brass stop-flutes to quarter columns on trunk and to columns on hood with architectural brass caps. Flame-veneered long door to trunk with arch top. The base of case with moulded applied decoration, the whole raised on a double stepped plinth base. A supremely elegant late eighteenth century Georgian period long-case clock with real style and presence. (Keys to hood, case and movement) H 96". W 20" D 20" England c.1785.
