Description

Late C19th Japanese Meiji period lacquer shodana or cabinet-on-stand. Stylish exotic black and gold lacquered Japanese cabinet on a cabriole leg stand with an asymmetrical arrangement of drawers, shelves and cupboards. Traditional painted decoration featuring flowers, plants, birds and landscapes with mother of pearl / abalone-shell inlaid detailing. The interior of the doors with further decoration in contrasting coloured lacquer. The inside of the drawer linings also having been lacquered. The top of the cabinet with a panel of extensive decoration, the ends having circular 'mons' motifs (family crests). Fitted with patinated as bronze, engraved metal mounts. Some minor historic wear and chips to the cabinet, the shaped cabriole leg stand with some damage and losses to the lacquer, particularly to the 'knees'. Constructed in 2 parts for ease of movement and transportation. Finished and decorated to all sides, of freestanding design. H 57" D 20" W 36". Japan c. 1890
