Description

A mahogany arts and crafts period marquetry inlaid display cabinet by Shapland & Petter of Barnstaple. The upper section having an arched panelled back with beautiful stylised marquetry and abalone inlaid detail. Flanked by twin rectangular bevelled mirrors with stylised slats and having Vosey style capped uprights. With central bow front glazed doors each having twenty one individual hand blown slightly convex glass panels which open to reveal two plate glass adjustable shelves and a silk lined back and base. The end panelled doors also with stunning stylised marquetry, abalone and floral marquetry inlaid detail, enclosing mahogany shelving. Raised on four square chamfered supports with block feet, united by a shaped under tier. The craftsmanship and quality of timber used in this cabinet is of the highest possible standard, the finest quality mahogany has been used throughout, even in the backboards of the cabinet and epitomises the quality of Shapland & Petters work circa 1900-1910.
