This unusual piece is lucky enough to have retained it's original molded glass liner and in undamaged condition. The stand of the frame has a mark for the silversmith, William Briggs and Company of Sheffield. Dating to the late Victorian era, around 1900, it remains in excellent condition, measuring 5" long x 2" wide x 4 1/2" tall.
