The highly intricate weaving in what were once utilitarian bags, is quite remarkable. Woven by Timuri tribes in western Afghanistan during the last quarter of the 19th century, these saddlebags are complete and in original condition - a rare thing these days as most were cut in half in Iran before arriving in the West, with the intention of using as large cushions!
