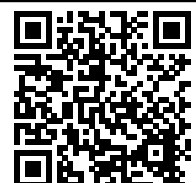

There are two lidded compartments, for nibs, a seal, sealing wax, clips etc. and to the front a rocking removable pen tray. The campaign style inkwell is the original and remaining in beautiful condition, a glass ink with a silver plated lid with a bolt and a folding wing nut closure. Somebody over the years has painstakingly created a hand made woolwork tapestry to fit into the lid, a beautiful scene, featuring ducks on a pond, quite beautiful.
