A Beautiful Edwardian Period mahogany antique revolving bookcase. The square solid mahogany top cross banded in satinwood with a central Sheraton Style shell inlaid paterae. Each side having four vertical mahogany "slat" divisions and two mahogany shelves. The revolving top raised on a cast iron base with mahogany cross framed stretchers and porcelain castor's. Only the better quality bookcases of this period had iron bases. The use of iron was for stability and to aid the revolving mechanism circa 1900-1910 Dimensions: 20" wide x 20" deep x 34" high Top shelf 9" high Bottom Shelf 12" high Condition: This revolving bookcase is in excellent condition, the top has been re-polished.
