The body is engraved with acanthus leaves and the front has the engraved initials WRC in a cartouche. The inside is gilded and the lid retains it's attaching ring for a fob chain or chatelaine. Condition :- Very good. The lid closes with a pleasing 'snap' and the hinge is strong. The body is free from splits or dents. There are two tiny dimples to the top corner. Hallmarks :- Clear and readable. Maker :- J. Cook & Son. Width :- 2.25 cms. Length :- 3.5 cms.
