An extremely rare silver mustard pot, dating from the late 18th Century and made by one of the great families of silversmiths, the Hennell Family. This superb example is of barrel form with reeded decoration. The lid is hinged and has a thumbgrip. Inside is a blue glass liner. A splendid and rare piece. Condition :- Very good with no splits or losses. There is a very light 'flattening' to a small part of the base, commensurate with age and use. Hallmarks :- Full, clear set to base and matching part set to lid. Maker :- Robert Hennell. Diameter :- 5 cms. Height :- 8 cms. (to top of thumb grip).
