A good quality Victorian walnut lowboy standing on four shaped cabriole legs. This lowboy constructed in the late Victorian era incorporating early 18th century elements has a rectangular top being quarter veneered in burr walnut with a herringbone inlay, crossbanded edge and endgrain thumb mould sitting above three early 18th century oak lined drawers. There are two larger drawers flanking the central drawer which sits over a shaped and moulded knee hole, each drawer with a herringbone inlaid edge dates to the early 18th century retaining their original steel locks with brass engraved handles and escutcheons. The walnut lowboy with canted and fluted corners stands on carved cabriole legs resting on hoofed pad feet has been polished using a traditional method having a lovely mellow honey colour.
