A most unusual little square jewellery box dating to the late Victorian era, around 1900. Made from my favourite timber, Walnut, with an inset polished brass handle crowning the domed top (a minuscule dent to the back plate, mentioned purely for accuracy). Once the box is unlocked, the lid opens to reveal the original tufted silk lid interior and the fitted jewelry tray professionally re-lined to create a clean and very usable box including two ring compartments running either side. Underneath the top section are two drawers, each with a polished brass handle each retaining the original silk to the sides and the bottoms re-lined. The two doors each contains a glass perfume bottle, making this a most unusual example. Excellent condition. The footprint measures 7 1/2" x 7 1/2"; the box standing 6 3/4" tall.
