A wavy hood door edging and brass capped fluted hood columns. A swan-neck hood pediment with the original brass finial. An arched painted dial with gold and green corners and a well painted country scene to the arch. A date dial and seconds indicator. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Samuel Thomas of Swansea is recorded in Peates 'Clock and Watchmakers in Wales' book as working in 1791. Most Welsh Longcase clocks are from the Victorian period, a Georgian example is much harder to find. Height 7ft 8 "/ 233 cms
