An Austrian born in Vienna, Josef Lorenzl was one of the three foremost sculptors of the Art Deco period, along with Ferdinand Preiss and Demetre Chiparus. He specialised in bronze figures of highly stylised dancers with long slim limbs. He was also a gifted ceramicist, producing many pieces for the Goldscheider factory.
