A delightful and sought after example of Edwardian gaming ware. This is a rare Bridge gaming box, with elaborate silver mounted details. It comes with a double deck of playing cards (probably replacements, but complete) and six pencils. The interior is very unusual, being wooden and sprung to facilitate dealing. The lid is hinged and the lock and clasp are silver plated. A rare and desirable example from the Edwardian era. Condition :- Very good , with no loss, breaks or splits to the silver. The box is in good condition with strong hinges and closes firmly. The sides are somewhat rippled and the plating on the lock is a little worn, both commensurate with age and use.
