A charming and rare collector's item. This is a fine cut glass tea caddy from the Georgian regency period. The body is rectangular and had detailed cross hatch cutting, strawberry diamonds and fan cutting. The base is half flute cut and it has a mushroom stopper over a facet cut neck. These items are rather rare and much sought after by collectors and this is a splendid example of Regency cut glass. Condition :- Excellent, with no chips or cracks. There appears to be a slight reduction in the neck to one side, probably to remove a small chip. The facet cutting has been re-cut to minimise this. Commensurate with age and use. Origin :- English. Width :- 11 cms. Depth :- 7.5 cms. Height :- 14 cms. (including stopper).
