Fine mahogany case with inlaid and crossbanded details, swan-neck pediment, fluted columns, brass fittings and a long, slim door with flame mahogany veneer and shaped top typical of early in the century. Excellent condition, cleaned and polished in our workshops. Bright painted face with rolling moon, separate second hand and date wheel.
