All in full working order and lovely for everything to be totally original and untouched. The sterling silver panel to the front is hallmarked for Birmingham 1906, making this a true Edwardian example. The makers initials are also clearly present for the well renowned silversmith, Levi & Salaman. The silver has an very elegant ribbon and reed raised decoration around the edge.
