After Norbet Goeneu (1854-1894) - Engraving - 'Arabes A L'abreuvoir. A. Carart, Edit.Imp, Paris.Width 18cms and Length 27 cms Norbet Goeneu was a French painter, engraver and lithographer. Born in Paris. At eighteen entered the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in the studio of Pils. After Pils' death, and his replacement by Lehmann, was one of the group of students who rejected official teaching and unsuccessfully asked Manet to take them as his pupils. Exhibited at the Salon from 1876. Interested in depicting the streets of Paris, the scenes one saw there, the types one met, but also worked in Brittany, Normandy, Bordeaux, Flanders, Antwerp and Venice. Manet admired his work, and he was a friend of Renoir
