SOLD....Oil on oval canvas in Georgian carved wood frame. A charming small portrait of a young gentleman holding what is probably a riding crop. This is Alleyne's favourite size of canvas. FRANCIS ALLEYNE (working 1774 - 1790). Alleyne was an itinerant portrait painter visiting country houses mainly in the south-east of England. He specialised in small, oval three-quarter lengths; these are often highly sensitive and of considerable charm. Alleyne's portraits are often, but not always, signed on the back. This one is not. He exhibited at the Royal Academy in 1774 and at the Society of Artists in 1790. SIZE: 17.25 x 14.25 inches framed 15 x 12 inches canvas size. PROVENANCE: a private South-East England collection.
