A rare and collectable piece of mid-18th Century flatware. This is a delightful and early silver teaspoon with a shell-back design. The teaspoon is in Hanoverian pattern and has the original 'pricked' initials SH to the top reverse of the shank. Condition :- Very good, with no dents or splits. There is some shadowing from the original fire-stain and a few minor pinpricks, commensurate with age and use. Hallmarks :- Maker's mark (partly struck) and sterling lion. These early spoons only has these two hallmarks and town marks and date letters were absent. Maker :- only 'W' visible. Length :- 11 cms.
