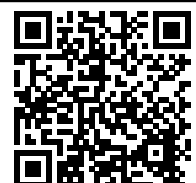
Description

A very stylish antique chair in mahogany by Kendell and Co of Leeds with a hand signed label by the workman who made it, "Boothe". This lovely chair has a deep, wide back on curved supports and stands on balluster turned legs. In original finish it has a lovely rich paitina in a warm mid-brown colour. It has been newly reupholstered in a striking modern leaf design fabric in shades of light and dark brown, beige and grey. It has the makers label underneath the chair which reads "J. Kendell and Co No.60404" along with the "Workman's Name" which has been hand signed "Boothe". A fascinating piece of provenance. John Kendell & Co were employed by the Earl of Harewood at Harewood House, Leeds between 1818-22, and at Farnley Hall, Otley between 1833-34 and adopted a policy of labelling their furniture from the 1830's.
