A charming little Chanteh (vanity bag) made by Luri tribes at the end of the 19th century in Luristan, western Persia. The indigo-blue field contains a large 'birds-heads' lozenge - the double-headed birds heads depicting the guardian of the gates of paradise symbolically. The back of the bag is woven in plain-weave technique. Bags of this size are very rare. Size: 18cm square (7" square).
