Description

This beautiful little chanteh (vanity bag) was made with knotted pile on each face using an over-dye madder-red which gives the red colour a bright shade. It was made by the Kashkuli sub-tribe of the Qashqa'i confederacy during the second half of the 19th century. I love the little peacock in the top right-hand corner of one face - a symbol of prosperity. Small chantehs like this are now extremely rare. Size: 19cm x 20cm (7.5" x 8").
