Elegant and very pleasing to look at, identified as Lincolnshire chairs and made by Thomas Marsh or his son, James in Sleaford, between 1820 and 1840 this is a near matched pair of Yew wood and Elm stick back elbow chairs with crooked arms raised on turned supports joined by stretchers. Generally in very good condition, the pair have a great colour and patina, there is evidence of old woodworm but it is inactive. Size Heights - 38.5" and 37" (98 & 94cms) Width between arms, both - 21.5" (54cms) Width, seat - 19.5" and 19" (49.5 & 48cms) Depth, seat - 15" and 16" (38 & 41cms)
