Always a popular one with the designers and decorators, these small bachelor tea services add a wonderful finishing touch to almost any room. This one is particularly decorative, with its fluted, scrolled, floral and foliate repoussé decoration, surrounding large cartouches. The sugar and milk jug retain an original gilded interior. The underside of the teapot is marked Nowill, presumably a trade mark used by this silversmith, the maker's mark I haven't as yet identified, D* in a shield and A in a second shield. Dating to the late Victorian or early Edwardian period, 1890/1910, it remains in excellent condition. The teapot measures 9" handle to spout x 5" tall to top of Ebony finial; the sugar measuring 5 1/2" handle to handle x 3 1/4" tall to top of handle; the milk jug or creamer measures 4 1/8" spout to handle x 3 1/4" tall to top of handle.
