A 'cottage' Georgian longcase clock of small proportions. An oak case with mahogany crossbanding and inlays. Brass capped hood columns. A brass dial with corner spandrels and central engraving. Date and seconds dials. A silvered chapter ring. A 30 hour mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Samuel Liddell of Old Swinford (near Stourbridge) worked in the 18th century. Joseph Liddell is recorded in Baillies' 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of The World' book as working in 1760. Height 6ft 3 "/ 192 cms
